

Entry Door Installation Instructions

Materials supplied:

- (1) 3' or 4' aluminum retainer for the header depending on kit size
- (4) 3' 6" aluminum retainers for the sides, two needed per side Enough brush or bulb seal depending on the kit for the above retainers

Tools needed: Tape measure, Hacksaw, Phillips head screwdriver, Drill, Scissors or snips

Installing the header seal

Measure the header of the entry door opening
Cut the 3 foot or 4 foot aluminum retainer to the width of the header
Slide the brush or bulb seal into the retainer trimming it to match the aluminum
With the door closed, hold the weather seal against the header
Sliding the assembly towards the door until the seal touches
Apply slight pressure against the door to insure a tight seal
Install the screws while holding the assembly in place

Installing the two side seals

Next, measure for the sides

Measure from the threshold to the bottom of the newly installed header seal Two 3′ 6″ pieces of aluminum retainer are needed per side Cut one of the 3′ 6″ pieces of the aluminum retainer as needed to the height Depending on the style kit:

Bulb seal kit: Slide one continuous piece of bulb seal into the two retainers trimming it to

match the overall length of the aluminum retainers

Brush seal kit: Slide one 3' and one 4' piece of brush into the two retainers trimming it to

match the overall length of the aluminum retainers

Slide the assembly toward the door until the seal touches Apply slight pressure against the door to insure a tight seal Install the screws while holding the assembly in place Repeat the above steps for the other side seal
